All field trips are held on Thurs and Fri in Sept and Oct from 10a-2p
Minimum of 15 students required to book a field trip

HOW IT WORKS

Field trips at Jeter Mountain Farm are self-guided. Upon arrival, our team will greet your group and give you a field trip packet and customized itinerary built just for you! Activities last from 10a-12p, leaving time for your group to eat lunch and enjoy the playground (or whatever your favorite part of the farm is!) for the rest of the afternoon. Your group will be responsible to get from one activity to the next, though JMF staff will lead certain activities once you get there. Visits with us work best if you have a clear group leader willing to lead the charge, but don't worry - we will provide you with a wealth of information, facts and discussion questions to make sure your group gets the most of your visit to the farm!
